Editorial

All praise is due to Allah (SWT), and peace & blessing on his noble Messengers (AS), in particular, on the last of them all the blessed Prophet Muhammad (SAAW).

It appears as if our rulers have finally decided to let the cat out of the bag and what an ugly sight it has been for the 190 million or so Pakistani Muslims. The ratification of the so-called women's protection bill in the Punjab assembly and the lead up to it, including the Oscar nomination and win of Ms. Chinoy's skewed documentary, the message-ridden episode of Mumtaz Qadri's hanging while the root of the whole issue Asiah Bibi remains 'unharmd', twists, turns and then new twists. All in all, it is the narrative of the state that has been shaped over the last 15 years or so and now it has finally been made public.

Lahore (PR): “The government has pleased its Western masters by sending Mumtaz Qadri to the gallows.”

This was said by the Ameer of Tanzeem e Islami, **Hafiz Aakif Saeed**, in a statement. He remarked that murderers of Pakistanis such as Raymond Davis are protected and repatriated safely out of the country by our government, using Shariah law as a guise, while the punishment of convicted Asia Bibi, who had openly admitted to the blasphemy charge against her, had not been implemented as yet. He added that it was a pipedream of the government that it could extend its rule by pleasing the U.S. and its Western allies.

The Ameer said that our history has proven that the West uses its agents ruling Pakistan to carry out such instructions, only to turn around and blackmail the same rulers into enmity against the nation and the religion. He concluded by lamenting that implementation of the death penalty of the Ashiq-e-Rasul Mumtaz Qadri was a disgraceful act of the present government and added that all those responsible would be answerable on the Day of Judgement.

Lahore (PR): “The fear of accountability has forced the government and the opposition to align mutually.”

This was said by the caretaker Ameer of Tanzeem e Islami, **Chaudhry Rehmetullah Buttr**, in a statement. The caretaker Ameer noted that when the operation against ransom money demands and target killing was initiated in Karachi, MQM started whining and grumbling and when action against corruption and economic terrorism was commenced by NAB and the FIA, the Sindh Government displayed the same attitude. He continued by remarking that now that NAB had extended its operation to Punjab by tightening the screws on some of the big-fish involved in scams, the PM of Pakistan, Nawaz Sharif, had started to moan & complain, so much so that he has publicly threatened NAB and demanded, in the presence of media, for NAB to discontinue its accountability process in the province or else the federal government would be ‘forced to use its authority’ against the National Accountability Bureau! Rumors had already started circulating in Islamabad that the federal government was planning on introducing new legislation to clip the wings of NAB and limit the scope of its operation against corruption, he added. The caretaker Ameer said that ‘Justice’ was the catchword of Islam and the Religion of Truth demanded that Absolute Justice be upheld along with all its requisites under all circumstances.

He noted that the Prophet (SAAW) is reported to have said that (hypothetically) even if his (SAAW) own daughter, Fatima bint Muhammad (RA), was (hypothetically) found guilty of committing theft, her (RA) hand would be severed as punishment in the same way as any other person – an example used to illustrate and underscore the importance of Justice in Islam. He added that the Prophet (SAAW) is also reported to have said that such nations, where different sets of law are in place for the rich and the poor, with the rich dominating the law and getting favors, are inevitably destroyed.

The caretaker Ameer concluded his statement by asserting that Pakistan must be made a genuine Islamic Country because the system bestowed on us, which we commonly refer to as the ‘System of Muhammad (SAAW), is the only system of governance that guaranteed the implementation of ‘Absolute Justice’ at all levels of the society. Period.
